We have had one new level 1 coach qualify this year who is now a paid member of staff. We also have 5 members who are in the process of completing their level 1 general gymnastics course, 3 of which are former gymnasts. We have had coaches qualify in a range of disciplines including pre-school, women's and men's artistic and we have 2 coaches enrolled on a level 2 women's artistic course. All coaches must have a current British Gymnastics enhanced DBS check and have attended a safeguarding and protecting children course before they can start to assist in classes, they are then added as a BG member. All coaching assistants are making a huge difference to our classes and we hope to help them progress onto coaching courses in the future.

We have had 8 new club judges and 1 new regional judge qualify this year, some of which have already judged at grades competitions.

Congratulations to all coaches and judges on your new qualifications and excellent work you do for the club.

We would like to thank our amazing volunteers who regularly help with office administration and the running and cleaning of the tuck shop, we cannot thank you enough for your continued support.

Our Leadership Academy has a fantastic bunch of enthusiastic leaders with many regularly assisting with classes. The academy has had an intro to volunteering course and a workshop on "clean language" and The Chimp Paradox. The leaders have helped with a range of events including inhouse competitions and a regional display event. We are finding that the leaders are an invaluable part of the Aspire family and we look forwards to exciting times ahead as they develop their gymnastic skills and experience.
